Guadalupe River Sediment Removal

What: The Santa Clara Valley Water District will remove about 2,800 cubic yards of sediment along the Guadalupe River as part of its Stream Maintenance Program.

When: Work will take place weekdays beginning in early September for about two weeks from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Weekend work may occur in the event of delays.



Impact: Trails will remain open, though the trail entrance on the northeast side of Coleman Avenue and the Guadalupe River will see an impact during construction hours. A



crew of four workers will utilize equipment loaders, water truck, street sweeper, small loaders and 10-wheel trucks.
