Hello Rick and Doug,

I wanted to touch base with you regarding the result of the letter sent by the Santa Clara Valley Water District's Redistricting Advisory Committee, dated April 19, 2011, and related to the issue with the California Statewide Voter Database and Hispanic/Latino last names not being re-run through the Asian filters.

I received a voicemail late last week from Ethan Jones, the lead consultant on the Assembly Elections and Redistricting Committee, and reached him today via phone.

Mr. Jones indicated that he had spoken to Secretary of State's office, and they are willing to provide NDC with the voter file, in order to enable Hispanic/Latino last names through an Asian filter in order to identify potential Filipino voters.

Mr. Jones also let me know that Mr. Johnson should contact the Elections Division of the Secretary of State's office, and they would provide the applicable voter file. If you experience any issues with getting this information, please do let me know so I may inform Mr. Jones.

Please do let me know if you have any questions or concerns, and I will be happy to further assist in any way I can.
