El ciclo del agua... Water cycle boogie.

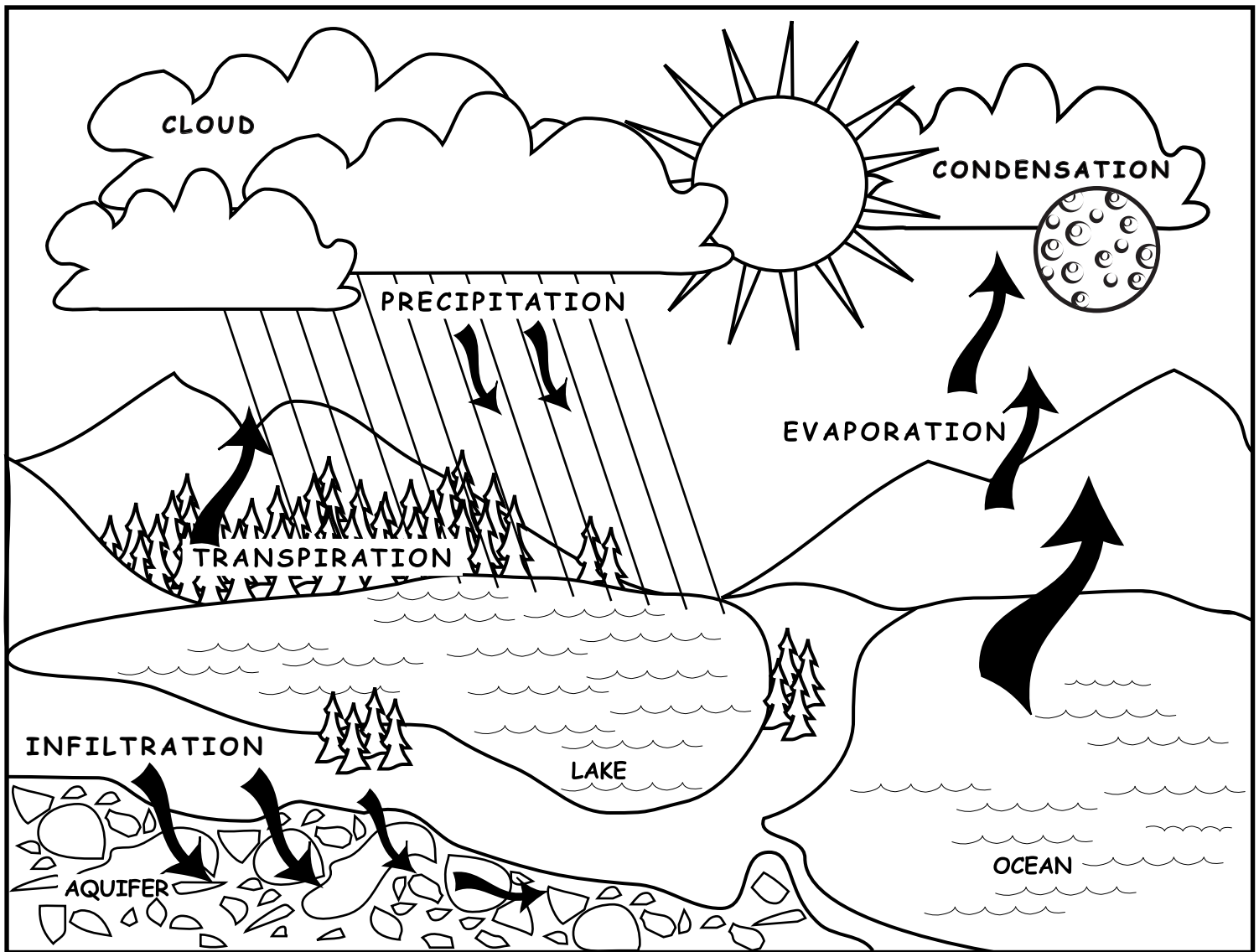
Precipitación llegó... Precipitation, rain and snow,
